Terms of use

Soccerbox Nachtigallenweg 86

The “terms of participation and use” are binding for participation in the University Sports at the University of Bonn. What’s more, the following binding rules apply to the use of the Soccerbox at RFWU Bonn:

1. Opening hours

The opening hours can be found in the University Sports booking system at the University of Bonn.

2. Booking

The Soccerbox can be used as part of supervised matches (course requiring registration) and/or as part of an individual session. Bookings can be made online (www.sport.uni-bonn.de) or via the University Sports office.

Individual bookings can only be made by people eligible to participate in the University Sports.

Individual bookings are subject to a fee. Before the match begins, the user must report to the groundskeeper/supervisor! The booking slip is to be presented to the University Sports together with the access authorization, and photo ID shown to the groundskeeper/supervisor.

Your booking is binding! It is only possible to cancel booked services in exceptional cases as a result of the workload that this involves.

In the event that the individual booking is cancelled within 7 days before the booked appointment, a cancellation fee amounting to 50% of the fee is charged, where the reserved appointment is not allocated to another participant. A processing fee of 5% of the fee, at least €3, is charged for every cancellation; the processing fee is added to the cancellation fee. In the event that an individual booking is cancelled less than 24 hours before the booked appointment, there is no right to a refund!

If the University Sports has to cancel an appointment, this is always undertaken by the University Sports office by e-mail, or also by telephone if it is at very short notice (on the same day). In such cases, the fee is refunded in full with no deductions.

Current information, such as special events or similar, can be found in the reservation plan on the Internet or on the notice board. In this case, the facilities can be closed by the University Sports.

2. Proper use

All facilities are to be used in an appropriate and careful manner.

The artificial turf pitch should only be walked on in the indicated areas. Any soiling of the artificial turf is to be avoided; in particular, it is prohibited to bring hard objects (stones, glass, etc.) with you.

Chewing gum, candy, soft drinks and similar sticky types of food and drink are not permitted while using the sports facilities.

The groundskeeper/supervisor is to be informed as soon as possible about any damage or soiling.

It is permitted to use the Soccerbox with studded shoes or boots – with the exception of metal studs of any kind. If this rule is not observed, the person will be banned from using these sports facilities!

Balls and bibs are available from the groundskeeper/supervisor free of charge against a deposit.

The floodlights are only switched on by authorized persons.

The use of glass bottles etc. is not permitted on or in the Soccerbox!

The provision of courses not authorized by the University Sports is prohibited!

The person who made the booking is liable in full for damage caused by improper use or negligence.

The orders of the groundskeeper/supervisor must be obeyed.

If the aforementioned rules are not observed, authorization or subscription can be withdrawn with no right to a refund.

Warning

It is possible to get caught in the nets due to rings and other jewelry! Risk of injury!
